PROGRAMME

THURSDAY, 4 JULY

18:00-19:30 hrs. Welcome to all participants while having a pizza or something else. Explanation of the programme.

19:30-21:30 hrs. "Carte de visite sonore", that is, we all present ourselves musically to each other by playing together in duos, trios or quartets.

until 12:00 hrs. Free time for visiting Basel or arranging playing sessions with others in the group.

13:30-15:30 hrs. Workshops 1 (probably 2 different in parallel).

16:00-18:00 hrs. Workshops 1 (participants may switch workshops).

Proposals for workshops

- 1. Awareness through movement Feldenkrais method, by Pascale Etcheto, dancer & Feldenkrais practitioner, and Valérie Lacamoire, dancer & psychomotricist A proposition for guided sessions for the exploration of full conscious movement; lengths of sessions: 45 mins; frequency: each day.
 - Time: in the morning to prepare mind and body for integration; at the end of the day for integration and recovery.
 - Material: yoga mat (there will be some spare mats available.)
- 2. Spatial awareness, by Pascale Etcheto and Valérie Lacamoire (see above)
 Proposition to contribute to the staging (spatial distribution) of the performance in the public spaces on Saturday.
- 3. Soundpainting and notating improvisations, by Etienne Rolin, composer, improvisor & soundpainter
 - Etienne will present his technique of conduction sign language for improvisors. The offered signs (10 to 15) will be presented in graphic form from the book of "Erolgraphs". All participants wil be given the chance to conduct upon learning codes and gestures to start develop and end an artistic idea. How we conceive an idea and express it with coordinated body language (related to dance propositions) to an ensemble is the goal.
 - Finally, he will use Soundpainting and Erolgraphs to notate a trio improvisation giving the performers an awareness of the overall form of an event. These tools are useful for textural recognition and real time analysis when responding to a "cluster" of information in the urgency of the moment.
 - This process allows us to answer the questions DO I hear myself musically? Do I comprehend the interplay with my partners? Do I imagine the result as heard by the audience of listeners?
- 4. *Timbral Music*, by Hans Tonino, logician, flute player & improviser At the EIMC-2012 in Basel, Hans experimented with "Silent Music," music played or sung so softly, i.e., at a barely audible level, that participants in his workshop experienced a different state of mind, perhaps similar to the experience Pauline Oliveros called "deep listening". In this workshop he aims at music played at moderate dynamic levels to create delicate textures and fabrics and experience deep listening in another way.
